I am writing to you within the framework of the Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (Uruguay Round), incorporated into the ARGENTINE REPUBLIC by Law No. 24,425, and its Regulatory Decree No. 1393/08, in order to bring to your attention, pursuant to the provisions of Article 5.5 of the aforementioned law, that a duly documented request has been received for the initiation of an investigation for alleged dumping in export operations to the ARGENTINE REPUBLIC of "Zippers and tapes, with teeth of base metal, of nylon or polyester monofilament and injected plastic", originating in the PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA, FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF BRAZIL, REPUBLIC OF INDIA, REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA and REPUBLIC OF PERU, merchandise that classifies in the tariff positions of the Common Nomenclature of MERCOSUR (N. C.M.) 9607.11.00, 9607.19.00 and 9607.20.00.
