**TIME-LIMITED SUPPORT FOR INDIAN EXPORTERS IN VIEW OF
GEOPOLITICAL DISRUPTIONS IN THE GULF AND WEST ASIA
MARITIME CORRIDOR**

Government of India has announced "RELIEF" (**Resilience & Logistics Intervention for Export Facilitation**) - an intervention under the Export Promotion Mission, vide DGFT Notification No. 65/2025-26 dated 19.03.2026, to support Indian exporters affected by extraordinary freight escalation, heightened insurance premia and war-related export risks arising from disruptions in the Gulf and wider West Asia maritime corridor. RELIEF interventions have been structured to provide support across the export cycle by covering the shipments already left during the disruption period as well as prospective exports planned to the affected region.

ECGC Ltd. has been designated as the nodal and implementing agency responsible for verification, claim processing, disbursement and monitoring.

In line with the Government's directives, the operational details of the RELIEF interventions are provided below for all stakeholders:

RELIEF Component I	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Meant for ECGC existing customers• Period of shipment covered (14.2.2026 to 15.3.2026)• Cover to be provided up to 100% at the existing premium rates• The Government shall reimburse to ECGC for the amount which ECGC shall pay to its Policyholders in excess of that is ordinarily payable under ECGC's existing cover
RELIEF Component II	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To encourage exporters to opt for ECGC Policy excluding energy shipments• Period of shipment covered (16.3.2026 to 15.6.2026)• Cover to be provided up to 95% at the existing premium rates• The Government shall reimburse to ECGC for the amount which ECGC shall pay to its Policyholders in excess of that is ordinarily payable under ECGC's existing cover
RELIEF Component III	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Meant for non-ECGC customers and to MSMEs• Period of shipment covered (14.2.2026 to 15.3.2026)• In respect of CIF contracts, reimbursement shall be provided to exporters up to 50% of additional freight and insurance• In respect of FOB contracts, reimbursement shall be provided to exporters up to 50% of the reduction between the contracted FOB value and the realized export proceeds• There is an overall ceiling of Rs.50 Lakh per exporter
