Subject: Continuation of RoDTEP Scheme beyond March 31, 2026

S.O. (E): In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the Foreign Trade (Development and Regulation) Act, 1992, read with Para 1.02 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2023, as amended from time to time, the Central Government hereby makes the following amendment in the Remission of Duties and Taxes on Exported Products (RoDTEP) Scheme:

The RoDTEP Scheme shall continue for all eligible export products for a further period of six months with effect from April 01, 2026, to September 30, 2026.

The rates and value caps as notified in Appendix 4R and Appendix 4RE, as applicable on March 31, 2026, shall continue unchanged during the aforesaid period.

The other terms and conditions governing the Scheme shall remain unchanged.

Effect of this notification:

Eligible exports made during the period from 01.04.2026 to 30.09.2026 shall continue to be entitled to RoDTEP benefit at the rates and value caps in force as on 31.03.2026, subject to the existing terms and conditions of the Scheme.

Subject: Extension in the Export Obligation period of specified Advance & EPCG Authorisations till 31.08.2026 - regarding.

In view of the prevailing geopolitical developments affecting global trade and logistics, and with a view to facilitating exporters, the Director General of Foreign Trade, in exercise of the powers conferred under paragraphs 1.03 and 2.04 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2023, as amended from time to time, hereby makes the following amendments in the Handbook of Procedures, 2023.

2. The following sub-paragraphs are added in the Handbook of Procedures, 2023:

4.40 (l). Notwithstanding the provisions contained in Para 4.40 of the Handbook of Procedures (HBP), 2023, in respect of all Advance Authorisations, including Advance Authorisation for Annual Requirement and Special Advance Authorisation, where the Export Obligation Period (EOP) (whether original or as extended) is expiring during the period 01.03.2026 to 31.05.2026, the EOP shall stand automatically extended up to 31.08.2026.

5.13(f). Notwithstanding the provisions contained in Para 5.13 of the Handbook of Procedures (HBP), 2023, in respect of EPCG Authorisations where the Block-wise Export Obligation (EO) period (whether original or as extended) is expiring during the period 01.03.2026 to 31.05.2026, the concerned Block-wise EO period shall stand automatically extended up to 31.08.2026.

5.16 (f). Notwithstanding the provisions contained in Para 5.16 of the Handbook of Procedures (HBP), 2023, in respect of EPCG Authorisations where the original or extended Export Obligation (EO) period is expiring during the period 01.03.2026 to 31.05.2026, the EO period shall stand automatically extended up to 31.08.2026.

3. The extension of EO period granted by the newly added sub-paragraphs shall be in addition to the extensions otherwise permissible under HBP, 2023.




4. No separate application, composition fee, amendment, or endorsement shall be required to be made or done by the Regional Authorities to avail this automatic extension of EO period.

5. In cases where the Advance Authorisation or EPCG Authorisation Holder has already obtained an extension of EO period upon the payment of the composition fee, the refund of the composition fee shall not be permitted.

6. Customs authorities shall allow exports accordingly. Compliance with Export Obligation (EO) in terms of the above provisions shall be examined by the concerned Regional Authority (RA) at the time of issuance of Export Obligation Discharge Certificate (EODC), closure or regularisation of the authorisation, as applicable.

Effect of this Public Notice: In view of the prevailing geopolitical developments affecting international shipping routes and global supply chains, and with a view to facilitating exporters, the Export Obligation (EO) period / Block-wise EO period in respect of specified Advance Authorisations and EPCG Authorisations expiring between 01.03.2026 and 31.05.2026 has been automatically extended up to 31.08.2026 without payment of composition fee. This relaxation is in addition to the EO extension facility already available under FTP/HBP upon payment of composition fees.

Subject: EPCG Scheme - Relief in Average EO in terms of the para 5.17(a) of Hand Book of Procedures (HBP) of FTP, 2023.

The para 5.17 of the HBP of the FTP, 2023 envisages that to provide relief to exporters of those sectors where total exports in that sector/product group has declined by more than 5% as compared to the previous year, the Average Export Obligation (EO) for the year may be reduced proportionate to reduction in exports of that particular sector/product group during the relevant year as against the preceding year. This implies that the sector/product group that witnessed such decline in 2024-25 as compared to 2023-24 would be entitled for such relief.

2. A list of product groups showing the percentage decline in exports during 2024-25 as compared to 2023-24 is Annexed.
3. All Regional Authorities are requested to re-fix the Annual Average EO for EPCG Authorizations for the year 2024-25 accordingly. The reduction, if any, in the EO should be appropriately endorsed in the licence file of the Office of Regional Authority and also in the amendment sheet to be issued to the EPCG Authorisation holder.
4. Regional Offices while considering requests of discharge of EO will ensure that in case of shortfall in EO fulfilment, Policy Circulars issued earlier in terms of Para 5.11.2 of HBP 2009-14, Para 5.19 of HBP of FTP 2015-20 and Para 5.17 of FTP, 2023 are also considered before issuance of demand notice, EODC etc. This stipulation should be part of Check-Sheet for the purpose of EODC.
5. This issues with the approval of Director General of Foreign Trade.

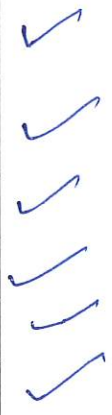

Subject: Special drive for expeditious issuance of EODCs under Advance Authorisation (AA) and EPCG Schemes - extension up to May 31, 2026 -regarding.

Attention of trade and industry is invited to the special drive undertaken by DGFT during the period **March 01, 2026 to March 31, 2026** for expeditious disposal of pending cases relating to issuance of **Export Obligation Discharge Certificates (EODCs)** under the **Advance Authorisation (AA)** and **Export Promotion Capital Goods (EPCG)** Schemes.

2. During the said special drive, DGFT Regional Authorities issued a total of **11,791 EODCs (till March 28, 2026)**, comprising:

- **7,518 EODCs under Advance Authorisation, and**
- **4,273 EODCs under EPCG Scheme.**


This has resulted in substantial reduction in the regular pendency of EODC applications.

3. In order to build upon the gains achieved during the month of March 2026, it has been decided to **extend the special drive for a further period from April 01, 2026 to May 31, 2026.**

4. The extended drive shall place special emphasis on disposal of:

- **older pending EODC applications;**

- **deficient applications** pending for long durations; and
 - cases where closure has been delayed for want of timely submission of complete documents / clarification by the authorisation holder.
5. Trade and authorisation holders are advised to make full use of this extended opportunity and extend timely cooperation to the concerned Regional Authorities by:
- reviewing the status of their pending EODC applications;
 - promptly furnishing pending documents / clarifications, wherever required;
 - responding to deficiency communications within the prescribed timelines; and,
 - approaching the concerned RA during facilitation interactions / Jan Sunwai, wherever organised for resolution of old cases.
6. It is expected that the extended drive would facilitate time-bound closure of old AA/EPCG authorisations and help in reducing compliance burden on exporters. It is further expected that issuance of EODCs would also enable consequential action at the Customs end relating to redemption of Bonds and release of Bank Guarantees, wherever applicable.
7. Regional Authorities have been advised to adopt an **age-wise pendency clearance strategy** and to prioritise older cases during the extended drive.
8. Difficulties, if any, in implementation of this Trade Notice may be brought to the notice of the concerned Regional Authority or to DGFT Headquarters.

Subject: Ease of Customs Duty Payment - Introduction of Payment Aggregator – Reg.

Madam/Sir,

Various initiatives have been introduced by CBIC in the recent years for facilitating the Trade by simplification of procedures, introduction of online facilities and improving transparency, thus leading to reduced time and cost during import and Export.

2. One such initiative is Electronic Cash Ledger introduced in April 2023 for seamless integration with the banks and introduction of deposits for subsequent duty payments. This has been extended to courier shipments in March 2024. Various facilities are being continuously added to ease customs duty payment including onboarding of additional banks for internet banking.

3.1 Taking this initiative forward, ICEGATE e-Payment platform has enabled Payment aggregator as an authorised mode to facilitate customs duty payment with the following features:

(a) Credit card or debit card or Unified Payment Interface (UPI) introduced for the first time for customs duty payment

(b) Internet banking through Payment aggregator mode will now allow payment through 41 Banks instead of 23 live banks integrated directly.

(c) This payment aggregator option will complement the existing payment modes such as Internet Banking through authorised banker mode and NEFT/RTGS payment through RBI.

3.2 As available in the other authorised modes, the payment aggregator mode also allows importer to make transaction-wise payment in the platform, wherein the systems shall route the payment instantaneously through ECL before accounting for duty payment.

3.3 It is to note that, as specified in the *Explanation* to Regulation (3) of Customs (Electronic Cash Ledger) Regulations, 2022, while making deposit through this mode, any commission, if any payable to the bank in respect of such deposit will be borne by the person making deposit.

4. Currently ICICI, IOB, SBI and HDFC bank have been onboarded on ICEGATE as payment aggregator. Subsequently, more banks will be added as and when the testing is completed with them.

5. Necessary legal changes have also been carried out in Customs (Electronic Cash Ledger) Regulations, 2022 vide Notification No. 30/2026 dated 24th March, 2026. A user manual on the Payment Aggregator facility to handhold and onboard users has been uploaded on the ICEGATE platform (<https://www.icegate.gov.in/guidelines/payment-gateway>).

6. This Circular may be given wide publicity by issue of suitable Trade Notice/ Public Notice. The officers under your jurisdiction may be sensitized to handhold the stakeholders for making payment through the new Payment Aggregator facility. Difficulties, if any, in the implementation of the above Circular may be brought to the notice of the Board.
